

**The Use of By Agreement Payment (BYA) DOS Codes
For Academic Personnel Activities**

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to ensure more accurate payroll designation and avoid the over-use of DOS “Description of Service Code” Code BYA “By Agreement Payment” in the Payroll/ Personnel System (PPS). DOS Codes establish how an employee is paid. BYA is not an appointment type and can only be used in conjunction with the specified title series and activity.

- Table 1 “BYA DOS Code Activities by Title Series” establishes the title code and activity combinations are properly coded DOS Code BYA.
- Table 2 “DOS Code Designations for Selected Academic Activities by Title Series (formerly DOS Code BYA)” establishes the title code and activity combinations that are no longer designated as DOS Code BYA and shows the correct DOS Code to use.
- Covered Compensation is discussed at the end of this document.

Effective Date: Effective July 1, 2008, DOS codes for academic activities should be applied as listed in the tables below. The August 2009 revision added title series, activities and clarifying language. The January 2010 revision added Additional/Overload Teaching to BYA DOS Code Activities and made minor formatting changes.

Covered Compensation

Generally speaking covered compensation includes regular salary, including off-scale salary and stipends. Examples of pay that is **not** defined as covered compensation are summer ninths, one-time cash awards, and summer session teaching compensation.

The following definition of covered compensation appears on page 25 of the UCRP handbook:

Covered Compensation The gross monthly pay that an active employee receives for a regular and normal appointment, including pay while on sabbatical or other approved leave of absence with pay. **Does NOT include:**

- pay for overtime unless in the form of compensatory time off;
- pay for correspondence courses, summer session, intersession and for inter-quarter or vacation periods or University extension courses, unless such employment constitutes part of an annual or indefinite appointment;
- pay for a position that is not normally full time except if paid on a salary or hourly rate basis;
- pay that exceeds the full-time rate for the regular, normal position to which the member is appointed;
- pay that exceeds the base salary as negotiated under the General Health Sciences Compensation Plan or Medical School Clinical Compensation Plan;
- pay that exceeds the established base pay rates, including nonelective deferred compensation, honoraria and consulting fees;
- payments received as uniform allowance, unless included as part of compensation for a regular and normal appointment;
- pay that exceeds the IRC §401(a)(17) dollar limit. For Plan year 2008–2009, the earnings limit is \$230,000. (For those who were active members before July 1, 1994, the earnings limit for Plan year 2008–2009 is \$345,000.); and payments received as housing allowance beginning with January 1994 earnings.
- Covered compensation does not include pay from sources other than the University of California.
