Ad Hoc Committees for Advancement to Above Scale and Promotion to Tenure Cases

Effective this review cycle (AY 2009-2010), campus-wide Ad Hoc Committees will be appointed on a discretionary basis by the Committee on Academic Personnel (CAP) to review promotion to tenure and advancement to above scale cases.

This change means that campus-wide Ad Hoc Committees will not automatically be appointed for these cases and that CAP will act as its own ad hoc committee in instances where a campus-wide ad hoc committee is not appointed. In those cases where a campus-wide ad hoc is sought, the process outlined in the CALL will be followed.

This decision was made by the Chancellor and EVCP in an effort to streamline the academic personnel process and to alleviate faculty work load. This change will also bring the personnel process at UCR more in line with those followed by our sister campuses.
