Tips for grant applications

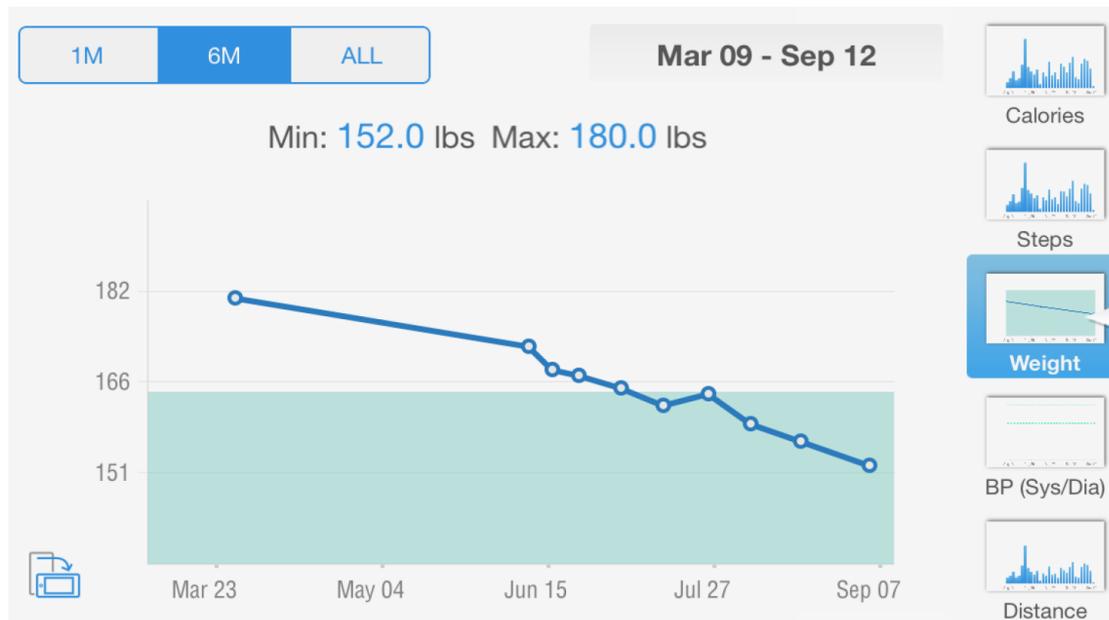
- Never give up
 - 0 chance if not try
- Try early
 - Learn feedbacks and justify accordingly
 - Let your program officer knows you
- Contact PO
 - Ask for his/her opinions on the ideas
 - Helps to interpret the review critics
 - Suggestions on how to address them
- Volunteer for panel review
 - Understand how applications are reviewed
 - Your colleagues know you were reviewing...
- Read awarded grants, carefully
- Get supports from grant personals
 - Mitch Boretz / Oscar Caso @ Engineering

Deal with stress & my secret email folder

- AP is stressful
 - UG, GS, grant, teaching, colleagues, peer-pressure, family, kids...
 - Stressful, disappointed, depression...
- Ask myself the following questions:
 - Is this the career path you want to chose?
 - Are you going to do the same if chose again?
- AP is another 5 year Post-doc
 - Great chance to learn new skills
 - Nothing to lose
- “Feel-Good” email folder, including
 - Offer letter from UCR
 - Grant notifying messages from PO
 - Cheer-up emails from previous advisors
 - ...

Wish I knew before

- Apply green card early
 - For travel and some grants
- Take care of your body
