Coro Faculty Leadership Collaborative

UCR has partnered with Coro Northern California, a nationally known leadership training organization to offer UCR faculty a Leadership Collaborative program that will takes place Spring 2025. The UC-Coro Leadership Collaborative program focuses on enhancing leadership skills and fostering relationships, networking, and collaboration. Participants benefit from personalized individual and group coaching; increased awareness of self and others; as well as enhanced learning, campus-wide networking, and greater employee engagement.

Coro facilitators serve as coaches and guides in the leadership development process. Participants will be introduced to tools and will have opportunity to apply them to real life challenges within the UCR community. Competencies to be explored and developed include:

- Critical inquiry in the UCR community context
- Working with different group decision-making models
- Planning for and creating community change
- Activating team performance
- Communication: active listening/effective speaking

Through interactive seminars, participants can expect to:

- Leverage understanding to improve governance and affect decision-making
- Develop the confidence to take more risks with creative leadership
- Create a support network and collaborations with other emerging leaders in the UCR community.

The program is designed for a maximum of twenty participants

• The success of the program depends heavily on the participant's commitment to the programs entire schedule. The full program consists of 10 sessions over 4 months. Each cohort takes part in seminars, intersession assignments and a group project.

• Faculty in a tenure-track position or already have tenure, or the equivalent.
