Re: Teaching Evaluation Changes in eFilePlus Effective 2025-26AY

Please be informed that effective 2025-26AY review cycle, the Teaching Information section in eFilePlus will include new labels and additional document types to support the APM 210 policy revisions (effective March 25, 2024) that address (1) consideration of mentoring and evaluation and (2) evidence of teaching and mentoring effectiveness. Additionally, these changes support the recommendations from the Joint Senate-Administrative Teaching Evaluation Implementation Committee (TEIC).

Over the past year and a half, the Academic Personnel Office (APO), Information Technology Solutions (ITS), Ken and I, in consultation with the TEIC and eFilePlus SMEs have been working to develop, test, and implement these changes in eFilePlus.

By fall quarter 2024, ITS will have development efforts completed and ready to demo to campus by early winter quarter.

Beginning with 2025-26AY, file preparations will reflect the eFilePlus features that enable the optional use of new teaching evidence materials.

The changes are summarized in the attached User Guide. Additionally, the 2025-26AY CALL will document changes as appropriate.

It is recommended to use the User Guide as a reference document after seeing what the changes look like during a demonstration. APO will provide multiple opportunities for faculty to attend demonstrations of the new features in eFilePlus during the winter and spring quarters of AY24-25.

Please note that the numerical and written student evaluations of teaching (SETs) from students that are collected via ieval will continue to be uploaded into eFilePlus. The changes described here provide for additional types of evidence for teaching effectiveness that faculty can include in their eFilePlus snapshots.









How To Use

eFile (for File Preparers and Candidates)

1. Effectiveness Evidence – the following optional document types may be added. The feature allows the user to upload a document (PDF). To add, click on the "+" sign. To edit and replace the PDF, click on the menu dots.



2. Additional Effectiveness Evidence – the following optional document types may be added. The feature allows the user to upload a document (PDF). To add, click on the "+" sign and select a Document Type from the category. To edit and replace the PDF, click on the menu dots. Similar in structure as Self Statement.



The following columns are available:



- Applicable Date = month/year (like Self-Statement), this will be used for a specific review type (snapshot)
- Action = review type based on snapshot
- Document Type = (a) faculty statement on student mentoring, (b) teaching portfolio, or (c) expanded faculty teaching statement
- Document = PDF of the uploaded document

Snapshot (for Reviewers)

- 1. For the new optional document types, they will be available in their respective sections.
- 2. The optional documents will also be included when a Comprehensive PDF is generated.
