## Recruitment Review

Allowed **viewing of the “Advertisements” section** to the search committee, as requested by UC Santa Cruz and approved by all campuses on the discussion list. Previously, Chairs, Editors, Reviewer and their “Additional” counterparts did not have access to the Advertisements page; now they do.

## Reports

The shortlist report now **includes names of the applicants on the shortlist**, along with their current status and a link to review them. The report used to include this information alongside gender and ethnicity data for those applicants, but that meant that the report could not be shared with many parties. However, some campuses want the shortlist report to serve as an easily shared list of who’s on the shortlist, so we’ve added back the names while keeping the personally identifying information out.
