We have added several new columns to the recruitments grid! Now, users can optionally **display any recruitment text field** in the grid for easier viewing and inclusion in CSV downloads.

Open rank recruitments

We've taken the first steps in the open rank recruitments project by implementing the ability to set up **multiple requirement sets in a single JPF**. With this iteration,

users will be able to add multiple requirement sets, customize their names, and add applicant instructions. This feature will continue to be developed throughout this project, and will be hidden behind a feature flag until a future launch.

Identity status management

We have been working on a new admin tool that will allow admins to track and replace files containing personally identifiable information (PII). This sprint we developed the foundation for this feature, allowing users to **view a list of files with potential PII** and the **ability to mark the files as “safelisted” or “flagged,”** meaning that the file does not have PII or may potentially still have PII, respectively. Access to this feature will be limited to admins for now and will be hidden until a future launch.

Identity status management

i Files uploaded to Recruit are periodically scanned by an automated system and flagged if the file seems to contain Personally Identifiable Information (PII). You can use this interface to review flagged files for PII, then replace or safelist them. Safelisted files will not be scanned again.
