We've added an **employee IDs column to the All Applications page**. This should allow users to connect hired employees to other systems more easily.

overstays, we added a set of columns that make this information simple to find. Users can **filter by expiration type, category, effective date, and expiration date** from the Waivers page.

When comparing data in the lists, it can be tedious to reorder columns. Now, users will be able to **drag and reorder columns** straight from the page!

PII audit tool

We are capping off our PII Audit Tool project with the addition of the **Replaced filter**. This filter will display all files that have been replaced, giving users an easy way to check their work and to confirm that a file they replaced was actually redacted.

PII audit

Files uploaded to Recruit are periodically scanned by an automated system and flagged if the file seems to contain Personally Identifiable Information (PII). You can use this interface to review flagged files for PII, then replace or safelist them. Safelisted files will not be scanned again.

Bugs 'n stuff

- Fixed an issue where user could sometimes not be able to save a workspace
- Fixed an issue where the recruitment grids would not render HTML
- Fixed the inconsistent casing of column headers
- Fixed an issue with repetitive text on Google search result
- Added two title codes for non-physician interns and trainees
