- Interest in collaborative dialogue
- Something is **falling between the cracks**
- You are unsure of where to go



Ombuds – VPAR/VPAP Role Comparison

	Ombuds Office	Vice Provost for Administrative Resolution (VPAR)
Constituents?	Entire UCR community - students, staff, faculty	Predominantly faculty
Scope of Issues	UCR-related concerns	Predominantly faculty discipline
Role?	Designated neutral	Designee of Chancellor and Provost/EVC
Reporting Office?	Non-reporting (Confidential)	Reporting
Can assist in informal resolution?	Yes	Yes
Acts on behalf of administration in formal faculty disciplinary processes?	No	Yes
Available to discuss issues proactively?	Yes	Yes
