





Chart of Accounts (COA)



- All accounting entries must be recorded and reported using this structure to comply with the UCOP Common Chart of Accounts (CCOA) mandate by 7/1/2023.
- The structure for the chart of accounts is defined in segments that represent the business operations. All segments will be populated, using default values as appropriate.
- Each segment in the COA has a distinct definition and purpose. When these segments are combined, the full chart string
 presents a complete picture of each financial transaction.
- Expanding to <u>nine</u> COA segments with a change in the order of segments.
- UCR attempted to retain UCRFS values and/or existing FAU structures where feasible
- UCR's new COA will be one of the largest changes associated with the new financial system implementation and impacts any individual who uses the current FAU structure to perform their duties.

Flex 1 & Flex 2

- These segments will be replacements for the Cost Center and Project Code fields.
- The existing Cost Center and Project Codes will not be mapped into the future state.

Flex 1: will be established by departments to classify details not achieved with other dimensions for prudent financial management/oversight.

Oracle Budget – Budget Management Overview

New Concepts for Budget Maintenance

Budgets will no longer be a ledger in the Financial System, but rather in a separate module called EPM

- Allows General Ledger to remain clean and at a summary level.
- Enables increased oversight and planning.
- There will be no more BEAs (budget journals) in the Financial System

Total Budget = Perm + Temp

- Temp = Carryforward + One-Time/Cash Adjustments
- Perm will no longer become Temp on July 1. Perm will stay
 Perm and be spent as Perm

Budget adjustments in EPM will be in real-time

The expense side of the Total Budget will be transferred to the General Ledger nightly for Budgetary Control of certain financial transactions.


- Any changes made to the budget will flow from EPM to GL budgetary controls via an overnight process.
- Budgetary controls, for non-projects, are absolute.

Budget to Actuals review will be key to budget management in Oracle.



Oracle Budget – Annual Budget Process Overview

The budget timeline outlines the process of annual budget planning, review, and decisions



- The annual budget process will be managed in EPM: This enables consistency, provides enhanced tools and increases tracking capabilities.
- **2023-24 Campus Budget**: Budget Data will be transferred from the current Peoplesoft environment to Oracle. Departments will monitor budget performance and make budget adjustments in Oracle Budget.
- **2024-25 Campus Budget**: Departments will develop their FY24-25 Budget Plan in the Oracle Budget system during the FY23-24 Spring Budget Process. The UCR annual budget process will span January through May with FY24-25 Budget Plan approvals occurring in June. Budget Plans will be available for Budget Execution on 7/1/24.
