Background

After several conversations with Faculty, Campus Leaders, The Graduate Division and Academic Personnel Colleagues, The Academic Personnel Office committed to providing a platform/space to support mentoring efforts on campus.

This platform/space would start out as two in-person events per academic year

The consistent thought was that APO could ensure continuity and provide support to those starting mentoring programs, as well as ongoing support for mentors/mentees.

APO could also be the central hub for resources and serve as a repository for all the mentoring efforts happening on campus



What We Are Doing

We are in the first full year of this effort

Today marks our third in-person mixer

We have collected information on the mentoring needs (from attendees)

We have begun to collect information on the mentoring efforts across campus

We have started to develop mentor training and will create "group mentoring" for mentors
