Welcome

- 1. Different faculty mentoring initiatives at UCR have been tried before.
- There has not been a particular program that has lasted very long and/or has had a wide campus breadth.

APO also aims to identify ways to leverage efforts from other UC campuses that have worked well, and even establish collaborative programs with sister campuses.
