

In our penultimate story, Recruit will now remind analysts to conclude their exemption, if they have not yet already done so, 1 and 7 days after the effective start date. If your campus would like a different interval, shoot us an email and we'd be happy to set up a custom set of dates.

In our last story to complete the Exemptions project, analysts are now able to **record a candidate's UC employee status**, including:

- whether the candidate is, or has ever been a UC employee
- the site that the candidate was last employed at
- their last employee ID, when relevant

We're ready to go live with the feature as soon as you are, so please contact us to let us know when your campus is ready for Exemptions! If you'd like some time to train analysts on using Exemptions, we will not deploy to your production site until January 8th, 2017.

#### Documentation

The **online helpdocs** and **user manual** have been updated to reflect changes from our last sprint, and all of Exemptions. Feel free to have a look around our documentation while you explore the new feature!

#### Bugs 'n Stuff

- The Exemptions appointments tab got some finishing touches in preparation for its special day.
- Final Approvers' approve and decline buttons used to disappear after opening their confirmation modal, but now they stick around like they're supposed to.
- Newly created exemptions no longer add erroneous information to their activity log. Similarly, applicant logs don't have erroneous information when deleting applicant files either.
- eTags for Shortlist and Search Reports now update correctly, so you'll always be seeing the most up-to-date PDF.
- We also updated our security subsystems to prevent the "Dirty Cow" SSL vulnerability.
