We've **split up some approver roles**, so you can now have approvals that require a thumbs-up from both your <u>Provost</u> and your <u>Executive Vice Chancellor</u>, or both your <u>Department Chair</u> and your <u>Department Director</u>. Remember that this also means that those roles can no longer approve for each other, and workflows for one will no longer include people who have the other role.
